### Clinical Status of COVID




## 1. International

- a. DG WHO has said that **opening up without control of COVID would be dangerous.**
- b. **US has surpassed six million COVID cases**, almost a quarter of the world's total.
- c. UAE has sent medical aid to war-torn **Syria to combat coronavirus.**
- d. Australia's Victoria state, epicentre of COVID infections in the country, **reported its lowest rise in virus-related deaths in two weeks.**
- e. WHO Director has said that Europe can live with COVID-19 without a vaccine by **managing outbreaks with localized lockdowns.**
- f. **Schools in England and Wales have reopened yesterday** for all students.
- g. **EU offers 400 Mn euros to WHO-led COVID-19 vaccine initiative.**
- h. **Canadian PM has said that Canada has reached an agreement with both Novavax and Johnson & Johnson** for doses of their experimental coronavirus vaccines.
- i. **Brazilian President has said that residents will not be forced for vaccine against COVID** once it is developed.

## 2. National

- a. Pakistan's COVID mortality rate has dropped **from 2.14% to 2.12% in the month of August and recovery rate improved from 88.8% (July) to 94.9% (August).**
- b. **Sindh Education Minister has said that SOPs for schools to be finalized in two-three days.**
- c. **3,342 police employees have contracted the virus in Karachi.** However, no new cases among police officers have been reported since the last five days.
- d. **Six tourists among seven people tested positive for coronavirus in Gilgit-Baltistan** during the past 24 hours.
- e. **Plasma immunization has saved 92 percent critical COVID patients** from being put on ventilators in Peshawar.
- f. **Pakistan has reported 486 more COVID recoveries**, taking the total recoveries to 281,459.
