




Cases Vs Recovery



Clinical Status of COVID





Death Analysis

1. International

- a. **China is considering to resume direct international flights to Beijing** from several countries, including Pakistan, on low fares.
- b. Bill gates has predicted that **COVID pandemic will be over by the end of 2021**.
- c. Scotland has imposed **fresh restrictions on the city of Glasgow** after a rise in coronavirus cases.
- d. **Italy's former PM Silvio Berlusconi has tested positive for COVID** and is currently in isolation at home.
- e. **British government has re-imposed local COVID restrictions** on parts of Greater Manchester area in northern England.
- f. **Uzbekistan conducted outdoor exams for 1.4 Mn university** applicants amid COVID pandemic.
- g. **Australia's Victoria state reported a triple digit rise in new COVID infections** for the first time in four days, denting optimism that a second wave of cases has been contained.
- h. UK is funding 500 Mn pounds (\$666 million) for **trials of rapid COVID tests and into population-testing for disease control**.
- i. France will spend **100 Bn euros to help pull its economy out of one of Europe's worst coronavirus-induced slumps**.
- j. Ford Motor (US) has said it is **targeting the elimination of 1,400 US salaried jobs** by year end as part of a multiyear \$11 billion restructuring amid COVID pandemic.

2. National

- a. **Federal government has issued SOPs for avoiding spread of contagious coronavirus disease among students** after possible reopening of educational institutions across the country from September 15.
- b. **Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) has amended its standard operating procedures (SOPs) meant to curb the spread of Covid-19** for passengers from Sep 2 to Oct 31.
- c. National Command and Operation Centre (NCOC) is considering a **random coronavirus screening for students and periodic testing for teachers**.
- d. IBA Karachi has cautioned students ahead of an expected resumption of classes that in case they contract COVID-19, they will **not be given any special consideration with respect to the attendance regulations**.
- e. Nearly 200 hundred Pakistanis stranded in India due to the coronavirus lockdown in both the countries, have **returned home via the Attari-Wagah border**.
- f. Islamabad, Gilgit Baltistan and Azad Jammu and Kashmir have **collectively reported 39 new coronavirus cases and one more death**.
