


Cases Vs Recovery




Clinical Status of COVID




Death Analysis



Deaths





Heat Map

1. International

- a. **The number of people infected due to COVID in India rose by another 80,000** and is nearing Brazil's total, second highest in the world.
- b. **WHO has said that widespread COVID vaccines not expected until mid-2021.**
- c. **76 countries have committed to join a global Covid-19 vaccine allocation** plan co-led by WHO that aims to help in buying and fair distribution of vaccine.
- d. **French drug maker Sanofi and Britain's GlaxoSmithKline said that they had started a clinical trial of their protein-based COVID-19 vaccine** candidate and aimed to reach the final testing stage by December.
- e. **Doctors in South Korea have agreed to end a two-week strike** after overnight talks over the government's medical reform plans.
- f. South Korea scrambling to control a second wave of COVID-19, **vowed to double its critical-care hospital beds amid a severe shortage.**
- g. **Israel will impose a partial national lockdown next week** to battle a COVID infection surge.
- h. Nigerian authorities have **expressed concerns by the low level of coronavirus test sample collections.**
- i. **Mexico has reported world's highest health worker deaths i.e. 1,320** due to COVID pandemic.
- j. **Police in Nepal used tear gas and water cannon to break up a religious rally** that defied a government ban on public gatherings due to COVID.
- k. **Thailand reports zero new cases for last 100 days.**
- l. Australian PM has pressed states to **reopen their borders and ease restrictions by December.**
- m. **Google is giving employees another day (Friday) off to avoid burnout** as the COVID-19 pandemic enters its seventh month.

2. National

- a. Chinese Ambassador said **President Xi Jinping's visit to Pakistan has been rescheduled due to the pandemic** and both government's are working together to finalize a new date.
- b. **President Dr Arif Alvi said the government is taking adequate measures to ensure ease of business in the country.**
- c. NCOC asks provinces to **ensure health guidelines, SOPs at educational institutions and increase contact tracing along with quarantining of affected people.**
- d. Federal Minister for Planning and Development Asad Umar has **cautioned citizens that second wave of COVID may be worse than the first.**
- e. **Federal Minister for Education Shafqat Mehmood rubbished rumors** that schools will remain closed till October, after some fake accounts in his name spread false information.
- f. **KPK CM has directed concerned authorities to conduct COVID tests** in all the districts where Muharram processions and gatherings were carried out.
- g. Islamabad, AJK and GB have **collectively reported 39 COVID cases and one death.**
