


Cases Vs Recovery




Clinical Status of COVID




Death Analysis



Deaths





Heat Map

1. International

- a. **WHO chief has said that world must be better prepared for next pandemic**, as he called on countries to invest in public health.
- b. India has recorded its highest daily deaths from COVID in more than a month with **1,133 deaths in the last 24 hours**.
- c. Dutch health authorities have said that **new coronavirus infections in the Netherlands jumped 51% last week to their highest level since the end of April**.
- d. British health minister has urged public **not to be complacent about social distancing**.
- e. Chinese President Xi Jinping has said **China acted in an open and transparent manner on the COVID-19 outbreak and it has taken concrete efforts to help save tens of millions of lives around the world during the crisis**.
- f. COVID outbreak has affected at least **23 Brazilian plants of JBS, the world's largest meatpacker**.
- g. Turkey announced it was **scaling back plans to reopen schools later this month, with only the youngest pupils beginning classes at first, for up to two days a week**.
- h. Hong Kong has said that it will allow **increase in size of public gatherings to four people and reopen more sports venues from Friday**.
- i. Japanese government has approved spending 671.4 billion yen (**\$6.32 billion**) **from the emergency budget reserves to secure coronavirus vaccines**.
- j. Australia's Victoria state is **deepening its contact tracing program to try to maintain a steady decline in daily new cases** amid criticism of its handling of the crisis.
- k. Saudi Arabia and France have agreed to **enhance the role of G20 countries in supporting global economies, particularly in the wake of COVID-19**.
- l. Chinese firm Sinovac Biotech Ltd (SVA.O) has claimed that **its coronavirus vaccine candidate appeared to be safe for older people**.
- m. **Siberia's Vector virology institute has completed early-stage human trials**, known as Phase II, of a second potential Russian vaccine against COVID-19.

2. National

- a. Punjab government has decided to **conduct random coronavirus tests of students and teachers across the province**.
- b. Punjab's Primary and Secondary Healthcare Department has **issued an awareness booklet to educate students about the COVID-19**.
- c. Aga Khan University's researchers have discovered in a study **on presence of antibodies** that **95 % of those who had tested positive for COVID-19 were asymptomatic**.
