### Clinical Status of COVID




## 1. International

- a. World Bank said that the ongoing coronavirus pandemic threatens to diminish progress made in the last decade in **improving child education and health**.
- b. WHO has said that **Latin America has started to resume normal social and public life** at a time when **COVID-19 pandemic still requires major control interventions**.
- c. South African President has said that **South Africa will open borders to most countries** from 1<sup>st</sup> October.
- d. Experts in Brazil have **cautioned against reopening of beaches and bars ahead of summer season** increasing risks of a second wave.
- e. Austria has announced to **limit private indoor gatherings to 10 people** amid rising COVID cases.
- f. **US Supreme Court has announced to remain closed for public** and conduct its October **oral arguments by teleconference**.
- g. **Mexican healthcare workers have received medals** for their efforts in combatting COVID-19.
- h. India has reported **record daily increase in COVID infections with 97,894 cases**.
- i. US manufacturers are increasing production of **cheap and fast but less accurate COVID-19 tests, aiming for 100 million per month by year end** that will enable schools and workplaces to significantly expand testing.

## 2. National

- a. **Pakistan has urged financial assistance of at least 2.5 trillion USD at UN forum for developing countries** to respond to COVID-19 pandemic.
- b. **Institute of Business Administration (IBA) in Karachi has been closed for two days** after the emergence of a COVID-19 case.
- c. **22 educational institutions across Pakistan have been closed in the last 48 hours** due to non-compliance of health protocols or standard operating procedures.
- d. Spokesperson of Indus Hospital has said that **phase 3 trial of Chinese vaccine for COVID-19 will be held from next week**.
