
### Clinical Status of COVID




### Death Analysis





### Heat Map

## 1. International

- a. UK government is **considering re-imposing a national lockdown across England** to counter the coronavirus pandemic.
- b. **Israel closed its schools**, a day before second national coronavirus lockdown, as daily infections topped 4,500.
- c. Mainland China **reported 32 new COVID-19 cases**, highest since August 10.
- d. **Denmark has announced to lower the limit on public gatherings to 50 persons from 100** in order to curb a recent rise in new COVID-19 infections.
- e. Dutch government is preparing **regional measures to combat coronavirus outbreak in specific hotspots**.
- f. EU has paid **\$ 384 million for Sanofi-GSK COVID vaccine**.
- g. Russia has approved R-Pharm's **corona virus treatment for patients with mild to moderate symptoms** and antiviral drug could be rolled out to pharmacies in the country as soon as next week.
- h. **French Open tennis tournament has been rescheduled to September** due to coronavirus pandemic and will be limited to 5,000 spectators daily.

## 2. National

- a. **Pakistan-China border via Khunjerab pass has been reopened for trade** and will remain open under strict SOPs until September 30.
- b. COAS General Qamar Javed Bajwa hosted a **farewell dinner for the outgoing Chinese Ambassador Yao Jing and lauded his contributions** for fostering strong ties between Pakistan and China and **handling the pandemic effectively**.
- c. Sindh Education Minister Saeed Ghani said that the **decision to reopen schools for grade 6 to grade 8 from September 21 has been deferred**.
- d. **13 educational institutions closed across country in last 24 hours** due to non-compliance of health guidelines or standard operating procedures (SOPs).
- e. Federal Minister for Education Shafqat Mehmood said that the **government is taking all possible measures to ensure strict monitoring of SOPs** in educational institutions.
- f. **37 school teachers in GB tested positive** for COVID-19 this week.
- g. **57 new COVID-19 cases were reported in Gilgit-Baltistan including 10 from department of education** and a tourist during the past 24 hours.
