## Clinical Status of COVID

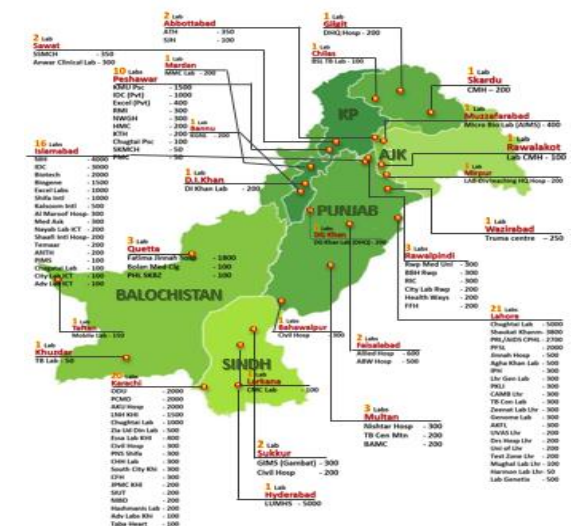
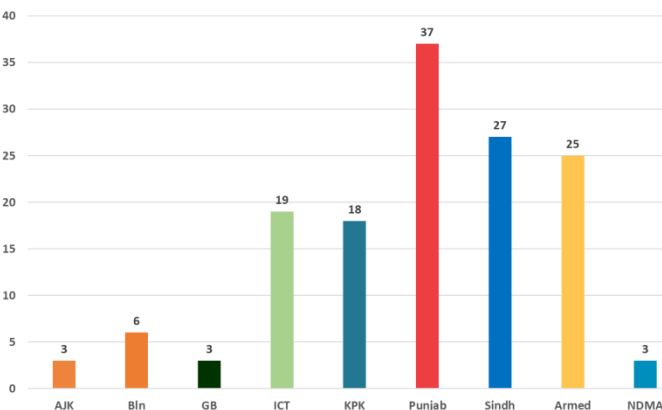

1. **International**

- a. **India's COVID infections surged to 5.4 million** after an additional 92,605 cases were reported.
- b. **France has reported 13,498 new COVID-19 cases**, setting another record in daily additional infections since the start of the virus.
- c. Russia has **reported new COVID cases above 6,000 for second day in a row**.
- d. Prime Minister Boris Johnson has said that people in England who break rules requiring self-isolation **will face a fine up to 10,000 pounds**.
- e. **AstraZeneca said that its COVID-19 vaccine trial in the United States (US) is still on hold**.
- f. Britain's health minister Matt Hancock has cautioned that a **second national lockdown could be imposed if people will not follow COVID SOPs**.
- g. **Madrid (Spain) authorities have announced a partial** lockdown to curb the spread of COVID.

2. **National**

- a. Federal Minister for Education Shafqat Mahmood has said that **any hasty decision to close educational institutions will "destroy education"**.
- b. Sindh Education Minister Saeed Ghani has said that the **provincial government can re-visit its decisions on opening of businesses and educational institutions if corona virus resurges** and can even take "hard" decisions.
- c. Sindh Minister for Energy Imtiaz Ahmad Shaikh has **tested positive for COVID**.
- d. Pakistan Medical Association has cautioned that the **country might see a relapse of the public health crisis if people continued to ignore COVID SOPs**.
- e. **All players and support personnel participating in the National T20 Cup**, scheduled in Multan on 30 Sep, have tested negative in their second COVID tests.
