### Clinical Status of COVID




## 1. International

- a. **Spain has imposed a new lockdown in and around Madrid** to contain coronavirus surge.
- b. **India has reported 75,083 new cases of novel coronavirus** in the last 24 hours, the lowest daily tally in almost a month.
- c. Mexico has surpassed **700,000 confirmed COVID-19 cases**.
- d. **Myanmar has planned to move ahead with a November general election** despite calls from opposition parties to postpone it because of a surge in COVID cases.
- e. PM Boris Johnson has said that **restaurants and other hospitality venues across England must start closing at 10 pm from Thursday onwards**.
- f. US Center for Disease Control and prevention has cautioned that COVID-19 could **spread through airborne particles that remain suspended in the air and travel beyond six feet**.
- g. CEO for API and pharmaceutical services (India) has said that **clinical trials of Russia's potential coronavirus vaccine are expected to begin in next few weeks**.
- h. Chinese state-backed firm China National Biotec Group (CNBG) **hopeful of receiving conditional regulatory approval for two of its novel coronavirus vaccine** candidates for general public use within the year.

## 2. National

- a. NCOC has allowed the **resumption of secondary classes from September 23** after reviewing the current situation of the COVID-19 pandemic in the country.
- b. NCOC has announced **that phase III clinical trials for the COVID-19 vaccine is being launched in Pakistan**.
- c. CM Baluchistan has **ordered education department to ensure SOPs in all government and private schools in the province**.
- d. **Government has issued new SOPs for government offices** after new cases emerge in the country.
- e. SAPM Health Dr Faisal Sultan has said that the **price of Remdesivir, used for the treatment of COVID-19, has been reduced to Rs8,400 from Rs10,873**.
