




Cases Vs Recovery



Clinical Status of COVID





Death Analysis

1. International

- a. **Bangladesh health minister has said that second wave of COVID has hit Bangladesh** and health department has taken necessary steps to tackle the pandemic.
- b. Health officials in Canada have cautioned that COVID infections have surged in Canada and if people do not take strict precautionary measures, they could **increase to levels seen during the first wave of the pandemic.**
- c. Turkey's President Tayyip Erdogan said in an address to the United Nations that any future **COVID-19 vaccine should be made available universally**, regardless of where it is produced.
- d. Helsinki (Finland) airport has announced to use dogs for **identifying passengers infected with COVID-19.**
- e. Interior Ministry of Saudi Arabia has said that it **will gradually resume Umrah pilgrimage for Muslims from October 4.**

2. National

- a. Sania Nishtar said that Ehsaas program provided a **relief package of Rs 144 Billion which was distributed to help daily wagers affected by pandemic.**
- b. **Public and private schools in the Federal capital, Punjab, KPK and Balochistan have resumed classes from 6 to 8** in the second phase of the government's reopening of educational institutions.
- c. **Punjab primary and secondary healthcare department has ordered suspension of nine health officers** in Lahore after it found "fake and fictitious entries" of coronavirus data during the month of August.
- d. Sindh Chief Minister Murad Ali Shah said that the **province's COVID-19 death rate has fallen but fatalities are still being reported.**
- e. **57 new COVID cases reported from educational** institutions in Balochistan.
- f. Federal government has decided to allow **pharmaceutical companies to increase prices of 94 lifesaving medicines** in order to end the chronic shortage of these drugs in the market.
