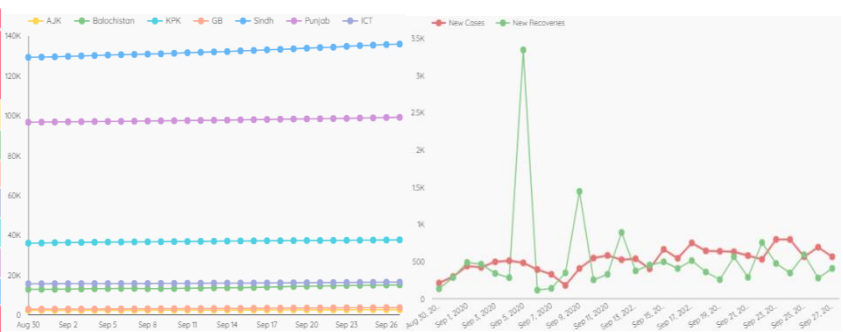

1. International

- a. **India's COVID-19 tally is nearing the 6 Mn mark, reaching 5,992,532**, as the death toll reached 94,503.
- b. **New York reports more than 1,000 new cases for first time since June.**
- c. US Army and Air force officials have said that the **COVID pandemic is adding stress to an already strained force.**
- d. **Protesters in Madrid have recorded their demonstration against a partial lockdown** that is being extended to more areas of Spain's capital region.
- e. **Saudi Arabia plans to resume tourist visas by early 2021 after months of suspension amid strict government measures to prevent the spread of coronavirus.**
- f. Victoria (Australia) epicentre of country's COVID-19 outbreak, **have decided to accelerate easing of social distancing restrictions as infections rates drop.**
- g. **Britain's Queen Elizabeth has planned to honour work of doctors, nurses, fundraisers and volunteers for extraordinary contribution** in COVID pandemic during her annual birthday next month.
- h. Indian PM has told the UN that **India as the world's biggest vaccine maker will use its resources "for all humanity" in the battle against the coronavirus.**

2. National

- a. **Islamabad District Health Officer has cautioned against the rise in cases of COVID-19 in Islamabad and has said that** Inbound movement was apparently the major cause.
- b. Federal Minister for Science and Technology Fawad Chaudhry said **Pakistan will soon become self-sufficient in producing medical equipment.**
- c. President Dr Arif Alvi and Prime Minister Imran Khan **underscored that promotion of tourist activities in rural areas could enhance the national economy and pave the way for Pakistan's development.**
